Notice of public hearings in terms of section 21(4) (b) of the National Nuclear Regulator Act, Act No 47 of 1999 (The Act).

The National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) is the national competent authority responsible for exercising regulatory control over the safety of nuclear installations, radioactive waste, irradiated nuclear fuel and the mining and processing of radioactive ores and minerals. Any person wishing to site, construct, operate, decontaminate or decommission a nuclear installation must apply to the NNR for a nuclear installation licence.

The NNR hereby gives notice to convene public hearings relating to the Nuclear Installation Site Licence (NISL) application received from Eskom Holdings SOC Limited for the Thyspunt site. The NISL application received by the NNR is limited to the evaluation of the suitability of the Thyspunt site for a new nuclear installation in accordance with Regulation on Licencing of Sites for New Nuclear Power Plants issued in terms of the Act.

Due to the increasing concerns around the COVID-19 pandemic and in compliance with National Government regulations around this changing situation, the NNR has taken a conscientious decision to hold hybrid public hearings in order to enable in-person and virtual participation from various interested and affected stakeholders. The public hearings will be held over two days at different venues.
